



Homeowner / Business Notice of Future Construction

Reconstruction of Main St. E.: Sherbrooke to Lakeshore Overpass

Construction on Main Street East is anticipated to start **May, 2011**. The proposed work involves complete reconstruction of the roadway including asphalt removal, and excavating for watermain, sanitary and storm sewers. New concrete curbs, concrete sidewalk and repaving of the road from Sherbrooke St to the Lakeshore Overpass are also included in the project. The project is anticipated to span 2 construction seasons lasting approximately **8 months**. The Works will progress in stages in order to minimize disruption to businesses and residents.

The contractor will try to limit the extent of noise and other construction inconveniences during this project. There will be delays and temporary changes in traffic movement. The contractor will assist in garbage collection and temporary access to businesses and residents. Drive with care in the construction area. There will be a City inspector available on site for the duration of the contract to liaise with the public.
